

EMERITUS DESIGNATION

PURPOSE

This policy establishes authorities and responsibilities for awarding the emeritus designation at the University of the Fraser Valley (UFV) to ensure compliance with the UFV Collective Agreement and appropriate oversight of the awards.

SCOPE

This policy applies to full-time librarians and faculty members at UFV after retirement.

DEFINITIONS:

Emeritus designation: An honourable recognition for retired faculty members and librarians.

POLICY

UFV may grant the Professor Emeritus or Librarian Emeritus designation to retired faculty members and librarians in recognition of significant service and outstanding contributions during an extended time working at the institution.

REGULATIONS

The following guide the process for awarding the designation of professor or librarian emeritus:

1. All emeritus criteria and procedures are consistent with statements on this award in the UFV Collective Agreement.
2. The UFV Senate develops criteria for awarding an emeritus designation. These criteria expand on the basic framework provided in the collective agreement.
3. The UFV Board of Governors provides final approval of emeritus recommendations as presented by the President.
4. The UFV Board of Governors may revoke the emeritus status and title previously awarded for anyone who brings UFV into disrepute.
5. The Provost's Office develops the process for nominations and any privileges associated with the honour, and ensures these and the criteria are published to the university community.
